**GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. The NOTICE OF ADMISSION will be issued at the POLO/testing centers.
2. Please bring original documents with you for final evaluation and four (4) pieces passport size pictures with nametag.
3. Examinees are required to wear the following attire every examination day:  
  
Male Examinees - White polo shirts with collar (without any seal, logo or mark)  
Decent pants or slacks  
Female Examinees - White blouse or shirt with collar (without any seal logo or mark)  
Decent pants or slacks
4. Bring the following on examination day:
  - a. Notice of Admission
  - b. Official Receipt
  - c. Two (2) or more pencils (No. 2)
  - d. Ballpen with **BLACK INK ONLY**
  - e. One (1) piece long brown envelope
  - f. One (1) piece long transparent (non-colored) plastic envelope (for keeping your valuables and other allowed items)
5. The following are **PROHIBITED** inside the examination premises/rooms:
  - a. Books, notes, review materials, and other printed materials containing coded data/information/formula

- b. **CALCULATORS**
- c. **APPLE, SAMSUNG AND OTHER SMART WATCHES, CELLULAR PHONES, EAR PLUGS, TRANSMITTERS, PORTABLE COMPUTERS, BLUETOOTH AND OTHER ELECTRONIC GADGETS/DEVICES WHICH MAY BE USED TO RETRIEVE DATA/INFORMATION AND/OR TO COMMUNICATE FOR WHATEVER PURPOSES**
- d. Bags of any kind (ladies bag, shoulder bags, attaché case, backpacks, etc.)
- e. Other examination aides not stated in this program.

All personal belongings of the examinees shall be surrendered to the proctor and shall be placed in a secured space within the examination room.

The rules on the conduct of bodily search, inspection of personal belongings of the examinees, and the seizure/confiscation of prohibited items during the licensure exam (Annex A of PRC Memorandum Order No. 57, s. 2020) shall be strictly observed.

### **SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Examinees shall bring every examination day the following: drawing boards not less than 24" x 36" with the corresponding T-Squares, set of drawing instruments, scale rule in english and metric, 60 degrees and 45 degrees triangles, protractors, compass, pencils, technical pens, erasers, cutters, paste or glue, stapler or adhesive tapes, 1 inch bulldog clips, water color, colored pencils, colored chalk pastel and rendering requirements.
- 2. Examinees shall provide the materials for the subject below:
  - **Interior Design**
    - 1 sheet A4 for Design Concept Essay
    - 4 sheets of A3 Tracing Paper for:
      - 1. Space Plan
      - 2. Reflected Ceiling Plan
      - 3. Elevation A & B
      - 4. Elevation C & D
    - 1 sheet A3 Paper for Specification of Materials and Finishes of
      - 1. Floor
      - 2. Walls
      - 3. Ceiling
      - 4. Others
    - 1 pc. Illustration Board (15" x 20") for Perspective and Color Scheme Rendering
- 3. PRC shall provide the materials for the subject below:
  - **Color Theory**
    - 5 sheets Water Color Paper A4
- 4. Examinees shall not be allowed to leave the examination room, borrow anything, or communicate with one another on any subject matter at any time during the examination period. Every examinee is requested to bring his/her lunch and/or supper (placed inside a transparent/plastic bag) on every examination day. The proctors/room watchers shall not allow any person to give or distribute food to any examinee while the examination is in progress.
