**GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Check or verify your school/building assignments at the PRC official website ([www.prc.gov.ph](http://www.prc.gov.ph)) or through the Notices/Announcements to be posted at the PRC premises two (2) to three (3) working days before the date of examination. Bring your NOTICE OF ADMISSION when you verify your school/building assignment. Visit your school/building assignment prior to the day of the examination.
2. Report to the school/building assignment before 5:30 AM on the first day of the examination to verify your room and seat number. Be punctual. Late examinees will not be admitted.
3. Examinees are required to wear the following attire every examination day:  
  
Male Examinees - White polo shirt with collar (without any seal, logo or mark)  
Decent pants or slacks  
Female Examinees - White blouse or shirt with collar (without any seal, logo or mark)  
Decent pants, slacks or skirts
4. Bring the following on examination day:
  - a. Two (2) or more pencils (No. 1 or 2)
  - b. Ballpens with **BLACK ink only**
  - c. One piece long brown envelope
  - d. One piece long transparent/plastic envelope
  - e. **NON-PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS** (Please refer to the updated Commission Resolution No. 1809-2024 or the List of Non-Programmable Calculators allowed to be used in the Licensure Examinations)

**NOTE: ONLY ONE (1) CALCULATOR SHALL BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE EXAMINATION ROOM. CALCULATORS SHALL BE INSPECTED AND HAVE TO BE RESET BEFORE THE START OF THE EXAMINATION**
5. The following are **PROHIBITED** inside the examination premises/rooms:
  - a. Books, notes, review materials, and other materials containing coded data/ information/ formula.
  - b. **PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS**

- c. **APPLE, SAMSUNG AND OTHER SMART WATCHES, CELLULAR PHONES, EAR PLUGS, TRANSMITTERS, PORTABLE COMPUTERS, BLUETOOTH AND OTHER ELECTRONIC GADGETS/DEVICES WHICH MAY BE USED TO RETRIEVE DATA/INFORMATION AND/OR TO COMMUNICATE FOR WHATEVER PURPOSES**
- d. Bags of any kind (ladies bags, shoulder bags, attaché case, backpacks, etc.)
- e. Other examination aids not stated in this program.

All personal belongings of the examinees shall be surrendered to the proctor and shall be placed in a secured space within the examination room.

The rules on the conduct of bodily search, inspection of personal belongings of the examinees, and the seizure/confiscation of prohibited items during the licensure exam (Annex A of PRC Memorandum Order No. 57, s. 2020) shall be strictly observed.

6. Read carefully and follow the instructions on your **NOTICE OF ADMISSION** and **EXAMINEES GUIDE**.


**SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. On the second day (October 8, 2024), the Board will provide five (5) pages of double sided graphing paper per examinee for the subject Principles of Naval Architecture.
2. On the third day (October 9, 2024), every candidate is required to bring to the examination room the following:
  - a. Drawing instruments: mechanical pencils/lead pencils (HB) 0.5, technical pens, pencil eraser, T-square 36" long, triangular metric scales with 1:25, 1:75 and 1:125 scales, triangles: 45 degrees, 30x60 degrees, ship curves/French curves, scientific calculator and masking tape.
  - b. A3 papers (A3 x 80 GSM drawing paper) and A4 scratch bond papers will be furnished by the Board. No books of similar titles, review materials and other examination aides will be allowed inside the examination building.
  - c. Excerpt from ABS Rule Book/Sections in the Ship Design Rule Book will be provided by the Board.
3. Use only black ink for the entire design examination. The use of colored ink other than black shall be considered as marking.
4. Candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination rooms, borrow anything or communicate, with one another on any subject matter. Every candidate is required to bring his/her lunch and/or supper (placed inside transparent/plastic bag) on the day of the examination. The proctors/room watchers shall not allow any person to give or distribute food to any examinee while the examination is in progress.
5. Examinees are allowed to bring and use drawing boards.

**NOTE: PERSONAL BELONGINGS BROUGHT BY AN EXAMINEE SHALL BE FOR HIS/HER OWN ACCOUNT. THE PRC WILL NOT BE ANSWERABLE FOR ANY SUCH ITEM OR PERSONAL BELONGING THAT MIGHT BE LOST DURING THE EXAM WITHOUT FAULT OR NEGLIGENCE ON ITS PART**
