**RATIFICATION OF APPLICATIONS FOR THE ACCREDITATION
AS ACCOUNTING TEACHERS APPROVED BY THE BOARD FOCAL PERSON
FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER 2018**

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 9(g) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9298, otherwise known as the "Philippine Accountancy Act of 2004", empowers the Professional Regulatory Board of Accountancy (Board) to promulgate accounting and auditing standards for the enhancement and maintenance of high professional, ethical, accounting and auditing standards;

WHEREAS, by virtue of this power, the Board issued Resolution No. 88, Series of 2008, entitled "Prescribing the Rules and Regulations for the Accreditation of Accounting Teachers", which requires the accreditation of Certified Public Accountants (CPAs) as Accounting Teachers;

WHEREAS, the Board issued Resolution No. 92, Series of 2016, entitled "Prescribing Revised Application Forms, Documentary Requirements, and New Fees for the Accreditation of Certified Public Accountants (CPAs) in b) Education Practice xx", which provides for the new application forms, documentary requirements and fees in the accreditation of CPAs as Accounting Teachers;

WHEREAS, the Board has issued Resolution No. 22, Series of 2018, entitled "Streamlining the Procedures and Reducing the Documentary Requirements for the Accreditation of Certified Public Accountants (CPAs) in: a) Public Practice (Firms and Individuals); b) Education Practice (Accounting Teacher); and c) Commerce and Industry Practice", reducing the documentary requirements for accreditation appearing in Resolution Nos. 2016-06 and 2016-92; and requiring submission of pictures of their principal office in lieu of actual office visitation and Quality Accreditation Checklist;

WHEREAS, the Board issued Resolution No. 40, Series of 2018, entitled "Designation of Accreditation Board Focal Person" which provides that all applications approved by the Board Focal Person shall be subsequently ratified by the Board concerned, subject to further ratification by the Commission, through a Resolution passed for that purpose;

WHEREAS, **ARLYN S. VILLANUEVA**, or in her absence, **GERVACIO I. PIATOR**, has been appointed or designated as the Board Focal Person to approve applications for the said accreditation;
