# PRESCRIBING NEW DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SANITARY ENGINEERS LICENSURE EXAMINATION

WHEREAS, Section 11, Article III of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 1364, or the "Sanitary Engineering Law", states that all applicants for registration for the practice of sanitary engieering shall be required to pass a technical examination which shall be given by the Professional Regulatory Board of Sanitary Engineering (Board);

WHEREAS, Section 17, Article III of R.A. No. 1364 provides for the qualifications of applicants for the Sanitary Engineers Licensure Examination (SELE), to wit:

- a) at least twenty-one (21) years of age;
- b) a citizen of the Philippines;
- c) of good reputation and moral character; and
- d) a graduate of a four-year course in sanitary engineering or BSCE having taken major subjects in sanitary engineering from a school, institute, college or university recognized by the Government or the State wherein it is established.

**WHEREAS**, the Board issued Resolution No. 01 (s. 2018) on the "Designation of Board Focal Person for the Evaluation and Approval of Applications to the Licensure Examination", with Annex A providing the list of documentary requirements for the SELE;

**WHEREAS**, the Board deemed it timely and necessary to review, rationalize and update the existing requirements for the licensure examination.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Board **RESOLVES**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to prescribe new documentary requirements starting the year 2024 schedule of the Sanitary Engineers Licensure Examinations:

#### FIRST-TIMER AND REPEATER

Degree/Course Requirement: (Please refer to Section 17 of R.A. No. 1364)

# **Documentary Requirements:**

- 1) PSA<sup>1</sup> Birth Certificate
- 2) PSA Marriage Certificate/Contract (for married female applicants)
- 3) TOR<sup>2</sup> with name of the course, date of graduation and S.O. (B) number, unless exempt therefrom due to accreditation of the course by the CHED.<sup>3</sup>
- 4) NBI<sup>4</sup> Clearance (valid at least 6 months as of the date of filing of the application)

5) Three (3) Certificates of Good Moral Character from any of the following:

a. Parent

c. School

b. Barangay

d. Office of Occupation or Supervisor

6) For a registered Civil Engineer to qualify for the Sanitary Engineering Licensure Examination under Section 17(d) of R.A. No. 1364, he/she must take MAJOR SUBJECTS IN SANITARY ENGINEERING from a school, institute, college or university recognized by the Government, as prescribed under CHED Memorandum Order No. 98 (s. 2017):

## Third year subjects:

- a. Environmental Science and Engineering
- b. Microbiology and Parasitology for Environmental Engineers
- c. Public Health Engineering
- d. Occupational Health and Safety

## Fourth year subjects:

- Environmental Planning, Laws and Impact Assessment
- b. Water Supply Planning and Development
- c. Sewerage and Urban Drainage
- d. Sanitary Science, Fire Protection and Plumbing, as applied to Buildings
- e. Sanitary Engineering Laws, Contracts and Ethics
- f. Environmental Engineering Laboratory
- g. Planning and Design in Environmental and Sanitary Engineering
- h. Water Purification Process Design
- i. Sewage and Industrial Wastewater Treatment
- j. Solid and Hazardous Waste Engineering
- \*After three (3) failures, applicants may be allowed to take the examination only after the lapse of one (1) year from the date of last examination
- \*\*Subject to payment of examination fees
- \*\*\* All examination applications (both first-timers and repeaters) shall be endorsed to the Board for technical evaluation

This Resolution supersedes Board Resolution No. 01 (s. 2018) and all other issuances inconsistent herewith. The Board may, however, make future adjustments or modifications in this list of examination requirements as may be reasonable and necessary.

This Resolution shall take effect after fifteen (15) days following the completion of its publication in the Official Gazette or in any newspaper of general circulation in the Philippines.

Let a copy hereof be furnished the *University of the Philippines Law Center* and the *Association of Deans of Philippine Colleges of Sanitary Engineering*. Further, herein updated list of requirements for the Sanitary Engineers Licensure Examination shall be included in the consolidated Table of Requirements for the licensure Examinations for the guidance and reference of all concerned.
