**RESOLUTION NO. 1939** Series of 2024

## **REOPENING OF THE FILING OF APPLICATION FOR THE FEBRUARY 2025 CRIMINOLOGISTS LICENSURE EXAMINATION FROM JANUARY 02-10, 2025**

WHEREAS, Section 7 (d) of Republic Act (RA) No. 8981, or the "PRC Modernization Act of 2000," empowers the Professional Regulation Commission (Commission) to administer and conduct the licensure examinations of the various regulatory boards in accordance with the rules and regulations it may promulgate and to determine and fix the places and dates of examinations;

WHEREAS, the Commission issued Resolution No. 1927 (s. 2024) scheduling the Criminologists Licensure Examination (CLE) on February 05-07, 2025, in various testing centers and the deadline for filing of application is on December 26, 2024;

WHEREAS, on December 20, 2024, the recurring instability of internet connectivity as experienced by the prospective applicants for the past two (2) weeks was reported to the Commission and Chairman of the Professional Regulatory Board of Criminology (Board);

WHEREAS, a significant number of applicants were unavailable to complete their online applications due to said internet connectivity issues in addition to the subsequent holiday declarations;

WHEREAS, in the exigency of service, the Board and the Licensure Office recommend the reopening of the filing of application for the February 2025 CLE to provide the opportunity for examination applicants to complete their applications and to be able to take the February 2025 CLE;

## WHEREFORE, the Commission RESOLVES, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to REOPEN THE FILING OF APPLICATION for the FEBRUARY 2025 CLE from January 02-10, 2025.

All Commission offices/divisions are enjoined to undertake the necessary coordination to ensure the smooth and orderly conduct of the licensure examination.
