APPROVAL OF APPLICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION WITHOUT EXAMINATION  
AS MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNICIANS

**WHEREAS**, Section 21(3)<sup>1</sup> of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 5527, also known as the “Philippine Medical Technology Act of 1969”, as amended, states that the Professional Regulatory Board of Medical Technology (Board) shall issue a certificate of registration without examination as medical laboratory technician, subject to compliance with the conditions therein prescribed;






