**SCHEDULING THE PROFESSIONAL ELECTRONICS ENGINEERS ORAL
EXAMINATION IN SINGAPORE ON 23 AND 24 JULY 2026**

WHEREAS, Section 7 (d) of Republic Act No. 8981 or the “PRC Modernization Act of 2000” empowers the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC/Commission) to administer and conduct the licensure examinations of the various regulatory boards in accordance with the rules and regulations it may promulgate, and to determine and fix the places and dates of examinations;

WHEREAS, the Commission received a request from the Institute of Electronics Engineers of the Philippines based in Singapore (IECEP-Singapore) to conduct the Professional Electronics Engineers (PECE) Oral Examination therein;

WHEREAS, the Migrant Workers Office (MWO) - Singapore has acknowledged the request and permitted the Commission, through the Licensure Office, to directly coordinate with IECEP-Singapore;

WHEREAS, there are at least twelve (12) examinees who have manifested their intent to take the PECE Oral Examination in Singapore;

WHEREAS, the Professional Regulatory Board of Electronics Engineering and Licensure Office recommend the conduct of the PECE Oral Examination in Singapore;

WHEREAS, to ensure the smooth and orderly processing of the applications for the PECE Oral Examination, there is a need to prescribe a period for the online filing of applications for the information of all prospective examinees;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission **RESOLVES**, as it hereby **RESOLVED**, to schedule the PECE Oral Examinations, as follows:

23 and 24 July 2026	10 June to 10 July 2026

RESOLVED FINALLY, that all applicants who have previously paid the application fee of ₱900.00 and who intend to take the PECE Oral Examination in Singapore shall comply with the following guidelines:

1. Applicants shall pay the deficiency of ₱1,300.00 at the Cashier of the Regional Office where they originally filed their application for examination, either personally or through an authorized representative. They shall likewise present to the Cashier a copy of this Resolution together with the previous receipt reflecting the initial payment of ₱900.00;
2. The processor of the Regional Office concerned shall put a remark on the system “With additional payment of _____ and the Receipt Number is _____ dated _____”; and

3. Applicants shall attach the official receipts along with their application documents, or they may submit a printed copy of the said receipts on the day of the examination.

Let a copy of this Resolution be posted on the PRC Official Website and Social Media Pages.
