1.2	The name of the Project is Provision of Security Services (2020) The identification or reference number of the Contract is: ITB No. 2019-001.
2	The Funding Source is: The Government of the Philippines (GOP) through the authorized appropriation under the FY 2020 General Appropriations Act in the amount of Php 1,960,455.55.
5.1	Bidding is restricted to eligible bidders as provided by ITB clause 5.1
5.2	None of the circumstances mentioned in the ITB Clause exists in this Project. Foreign bidders, except those falling under ITB Clause 5.2 (b), may not participate in this Project.
5.4	The Bidder must have completed, within the period specified in the Invitation to Bid and ITB Clause 12.1 a (iii), a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC. For this purpose, similar contracts shall refer to contracts for Security Services.
5.5	<u>The Bidder must submit a computation of its Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC), which must be at least equal to the ABC to be bid, calculated as follows:</u> NFCC = [(Current assets minus current liabilities) (K)] minus the value of all outstanding or uncompleted portions of the projects under going contracts, including awarded contracts yet to be started coinciding with the contract for this Project. Where: K = 10 for a contract duration of one year or less, 15 for a contract duration of more than one year up to two years, and 20 for a contract duration of more than two years. <u>The values of the bidder’s current assets and current liabilities shall be based on the data submitted to the BIR, through its Electronic Filing and Payment System (EFPS).</u>

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ELIGIBILITY CLASS “A”	The Bids and Awards Committee hereby declares, the contrary notwithstanding, that it affirmatively requires the prospective Bidders to submit during the submission and opening of bids documents in addition to those provided by the ITB Clause no. 11.1. Those enumerated under BDS Clause 11.1 (a) (vi) shall form part of the Eligibility and Technical; Financial Requirements.

12.1(a) (i)	“No other acceptable proof of registration is recognized.” The original Certificate of Registration shall be submitted. <i>In case of an amendment of the name of the Corporate, bidders must submit the Certificate of Filing of amended Articles of Incorporation certifying therein the new name of the entity, SEC certification as to the amendment of the corporate name, if applicable, as well as a <u>certificate of good standing</u>.</i>
12.1(a) (ii)	Valid and current Mayor’s Permit/municipal license where the prospective Bidder’s principal office is located. <i>In exceptional cases where the LGU concerned has not yet released the Mayor’s Permit, Bidders in lieu of the valid Mayor’s Permit may submit a substantial proof of renewal of Mayor’s Permit, such as Official Receipt of payment.</i>

Submission of eligibility requirements containing false information or falsified documents.2. Submission of bids that contain false information or falsified documents, or the concealment of such information in the bids in order to influence the outcome of eligibility screening or any other stage of the public bidding.3. Allowing the use of one’s name, or using the name of another for purposes of public bidding.4. Withdrawal of a bid, or refusal to accept an award, or enter into contract with the Government without justifiable cause, after the Bidder had been adjudged as having submitted the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid.5. Refusal or failure to post the required performance security within the prescribed time.6. Refusal to clarify or validate in writing its bid during post-qualification within a period of seven (7) calendar days from receipt of the request for clarification.7. Any documented unsolicited attempt by a bidder to unduly influence the outcome of the bidding in his favor.8. Failure of the potential joint venture partners to enter into the joint venture after the bid is declared as successful.9.
