**RECOMMENDING TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE PROFESSIONAL REGULATION COMMISSION FOR HIS APPROVAL THE AWARD OF THE CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF VARIOUS IT EQUIPMENT:
LOT 1 – FORTY-SEVEN (47) UNITS OF NETWORK SWITCH – REBID TO IMAX TECHNOLOGIES, INC. WITH A TOTAL BID AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE PESOS (P475,875.00)**

WHEREAS, the invitation to apply for eligibility and to bid through Negotiated Procurement under Section 53.9 – Small Value Procurement was posted in the website of the Commission, at the Bids Awards Committee (BAC) Bulletin Board, and in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) for the project: Supply and Delivery of Various IT Equipment: Lot 1 – Forty-Seven (47) Units of Network Switch – Rebid with Approved Budget for the Contract of Six Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Six Hundred Eighty-Four Pesos and Thirty-Three Centavos (Php654,684.33).

WHEREAS, during the scheduled deadline and submission of bid proposals on November 25, 2020, five (5) bidders submitted their eligibility and technical requirements, namely: HLYC Trading (HLYC), RNET and RJ4 General Merchandise (RNET), IMAX Technologies, Inc. (IMAX), SONKKENS Office Equipment Trading (SONKKENS) and Hundredfold Trading (Hundredfold) submitted their bid quotation.

WHEREAS, on November 25, 2020, during the opening and evaluation of its bids, out of the 5 bidders who participated, only IMAX passed the eligibility and technical evaluations, with financial bid quotation of Four Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Five Pesos (Php475,875.00) as HLYC, RNET, SONKKENS, and Hundredfold failed to submit duly accomplished Annexes A and B, latest income/business tax returns, and Secretary's Certificate, thereby receiving failed marks on the evaluation sheet.

WHEREAS, Section 30, Rule IX of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, requires that the preliminary examination of the bids be conducted by merely checking for the presence or absence of documentary requirements using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion. If a bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated “passed” for the particular requirement. In this regard, bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered as “failed”.

WHEREAS, IMAX was declared as the Single Calculated and Responsive Quotation.

WHEREFORE, the **BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE RESOLVES**, as it hereby **RESOLVED**, to recommend to the Chairman of the Professional Regulation


Commission for his approval the award of the contract for the project: **LOT 1 – FORTY-SEVEN (47) UNITS OF NETWORK SWITCH – REBID** to **IMAX** with bid amount of **Four Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy-Five Pesos (Php475,875.00)**.


