## LICENSURE EXAMINATION FOR ELECTRONICS TECHNICIANS 20 OCTOBER 2025

### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO EXAMINEES

1. Check or verify your school/building assignments at the PRC official website ([www.prc.gov.ph](http://www.prc.gov.ph)) or through the Notices/ Announcements to be posted at the PRC premises two (2) to three (3) working days before the date of examination.
2. On the day of the examination, report to the school/building assignment not later than 5:30 A.M. Be punctual. **Late examinees will not be admitted.**
3. Examinees are required to wear the following attire on examination day:
  - Male examinees - Tucked-in white polo shirt with collar (without any seal, logo, or mark)  
Decent pants or slacks.
  - Female examinees - Tucked-in white blouse or shirt with collar (without any seal, logo, or mark)  
Decent pants or slacks, pony-tailed hair .
4. Read carefully and follow the instructions on your NOTICE OF ADMISSION and EXAMINEES GUIDE.
5. Personal belongings brought by an examinee shall be for his/her own account. The PRC will not be answerable for any such item or personal belonging that might be lost during the examination without fault or negligence on its part.





## LICENSURE EXAMINATION FOR ELECTRONICS TECHNICIANS 20 OCTOBER 2025

Relative to this, all examinees of Davao City are required to bring the following:

1. Notice of Admission
2. Two (2) or more pencils (No. 2)
3. Ball pens with BLACK ink only
4. One (1) piece long brown envelope
5. One (1) piece long transparent/non-colored plastic envelope (for keeping your valuables and other allowed items).
6. **NON-PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATOR.** (Please refer to Commission Resolution No. 1809 (s 2024) or the “Updated List of Non-Programmable Calculators allowed to be used in the Licensure Examinations”).

**NOTE: ONLY ONE (1) CALCULATOR SHALL BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE EXAMINATION ROOM. CALCULATORS SHALL BE INSPECTED AND HAVE TO BE RESET BEFORE THE START OF THE EXAMINATION.**

6. For pregnant examinee, submit clearance from the OB-Gynecologists
  - ❖ Clearance should indicate that the examinee is cleared to take the licensure examination.
  - ❖ No OB-Gyne Clearance, No Exam.
7. Packed snacks, meals, and necessary medications, including hygiene and sanitary kits, in **TRANSPARENT/CLEAR** containers/cellophanes (**paper containers are not allowed**), with sufficient drinking water supply for the day. The room watchers shall not allow any person, including food delivery service, to give or distribute food to any examinees while the examination is in progress. Except for restroom necessities, no examinee shall be allowed to leave the examination room during the conduct of examination.



## LICENSURE EXAMINATION FOR ELECTRONICS TECHNICIANS 20 OCTOBER 2025

### STRICTLY PROHIBITED

1. Examinees are prohibited to bring and use **PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS** or calculators that can automatically carry out a sequence of operations under control of a stored program, much like a computer and/or with audio-visual features, and/or capable of external communication or internet connectivity, specifically **CASIO FX-991ES, FX-991ES Plus and FX-570ES Plus**.
2. Examinees are prohibited to bring and use **SMART WATCHES, CELLULAR PHONES, EAR PLUGS, TRANSMITTERS, PORTABLE COMPUTERS, BLUETOOTH,** and other electronic gadgets/devices which may store or retrieve data/information and/or to communicate for whatever purposes;
3. Books, notes, review materials, and other printed materials containing coded data/information/formula are not allowed inside the testing center premises.
4. Bags of any kind (ladies' bag, shoulder bags, attaché case, backpacks, etc.) and other examination aides not stated in this program are prohibited (place your documents inside the transparent/plastic envelope).

Bringing of the above said items inside the examination venue will be considered as **CHEATING** or an **ACT OF DISHONESTY**. If an examinee is found guilty, his/her examination papers shall be cancelled and shall either be suspended or debarred from taking future examinations.

The proctors/room watchers shall not allow any person, including food delivery service, to give or distribute food to any examinees while the examination is in progress. Except for restroom necessities, no examinee shall be allowed to leave the examination room during the conduct of the examination

  - b. **Calculators which are programmable or with embedded functions especially CASIO FX991ES and CASIO FX-991ES plus pursuant to Memorandum Circular 2018-01.**
  - c. **APPLE, SAMSUNG AND OTHER SMART WATCHES, CELLULAR PHONES, EAR PLUGS, TRANSMITTERS, PORTABLE COMPUTERS, BLUETOOTH AND OTHER ELECTRONIC GADGETS/DEVICES WHICH MAY BE USED TO RETRIEVE DATA/INFORMATION AND/OR TO COMMUNICATE FOR WHATEVER PURPOSE.**
  - d. Bags of any kind (place your documents inside the transparent/plastic envelope).
  - e. Other examination aides not stated in this program.

The rules on the conduct of bodily search, inspection of personal belongings of the examinees, and the seizure/confiscation of prohibited items during the licensure exam (Annex A of PRC Memorandum Order No. 57 (s. 2020) shall be strictly observed.

6. Examinees and examination personnel are encouraged to observe the minimum health standards per DOH Circular No. 0324 (s. 2023)<sup>1</sup> throughout the conduct of the examination.
7. Read carefully and follow the instructions on your **NOTICE OF ADMISSION**.

**UPDATED LIST OF NON-PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS ALLOWED  
TO BE USED IN THE LICENSURE EXAMINATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, Republic Act (R.A.) No. 8981, or the “PRC Modernization Act of 2000”, empowers the Professional Regulation Commission (Commission) to administer, implement and enforce the regulatory policies of the national government with respect to the regulation and licensing of the professions under its jurisdiction; administer and conduct the licensure examinations of the various regulatory Boards in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated; and adopt measures to preserve the integrity and inviolability of the licensure examinations, among others;

**WHEREAS**, the Commission, pursuant to its powers under the same Act, issued Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 21 (s. 2009), prescribing the list of non-programmable calculators to be used by the examinees in all licensure examinations;

**WHEREAS**, some of the models in the list of allowed non-programmable calculators under MC No. 21 (s. 2009) are found to be outdated since most of them are phased-out and are commercially unavailable;

**WHEREAS**, the Commission recognizes the importance of ensuring that the list of non-programmable calculators allowed in the licensure examinations are up-to-date and easily accessible;

**WHEREAS**, it is also important to have an updated list of allowed non-programmable calculators for the guidance of the Commission Regional Offices, the examinees, and other stakeholders;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Commission **RESOLVES**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to recommend the **Updated List of Non-Programmable Calculators Allowed to be Used in Licensure Examinations** as shown in “Annex A”.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the following additional guidelines be properly followed:

- a. Only one (1) non-programmable calculator per examinee shall be allowed inside the examination room. All calculators shall be thoroughly inspected by the examination personnel every examination day.
- b. Borrowing, lending and substitution/replacement of calculators while the examination is in progress shall not be allowed.

**RESOLVED FINALLY**, that:

- a. Professional Regulatory Boards (PRBs) that have their own list of allowable calculators may continue to use their existing *Resolution*, which shall be clearly stated in their licensure examination program;
- b. PRBs that prefer to have their own list of allowable calculators may issue their own *Resolution*;
- c. PRBs may completely disallow calculators in their licensure examinations which shall be clearly stated in their licensure examination program; and

- d. Calculators listed in MC No. 21 (s. 2009) that are still available in the market may be used in licensure examinations, with the exception of that mentioned in MC No. 01 (s. 2018) on "*Disallowing the Use of Casio Calculator FX-991ES and FX 991ES Plus in the Licensure Examinations, and other Special Rules on the Use of Calculators during the Licensure Examinations*" and Casio Calculator FX-570ES Plus which has been repeatedly discovered to have been used for cheating by, but not limited to, being modified to transmit and receive data.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately following its publication in the Official Gazette or a newspaper of general circulation and the submission of a copy thereof to the Office of the National Administrative Register of the University of the Philippines.
