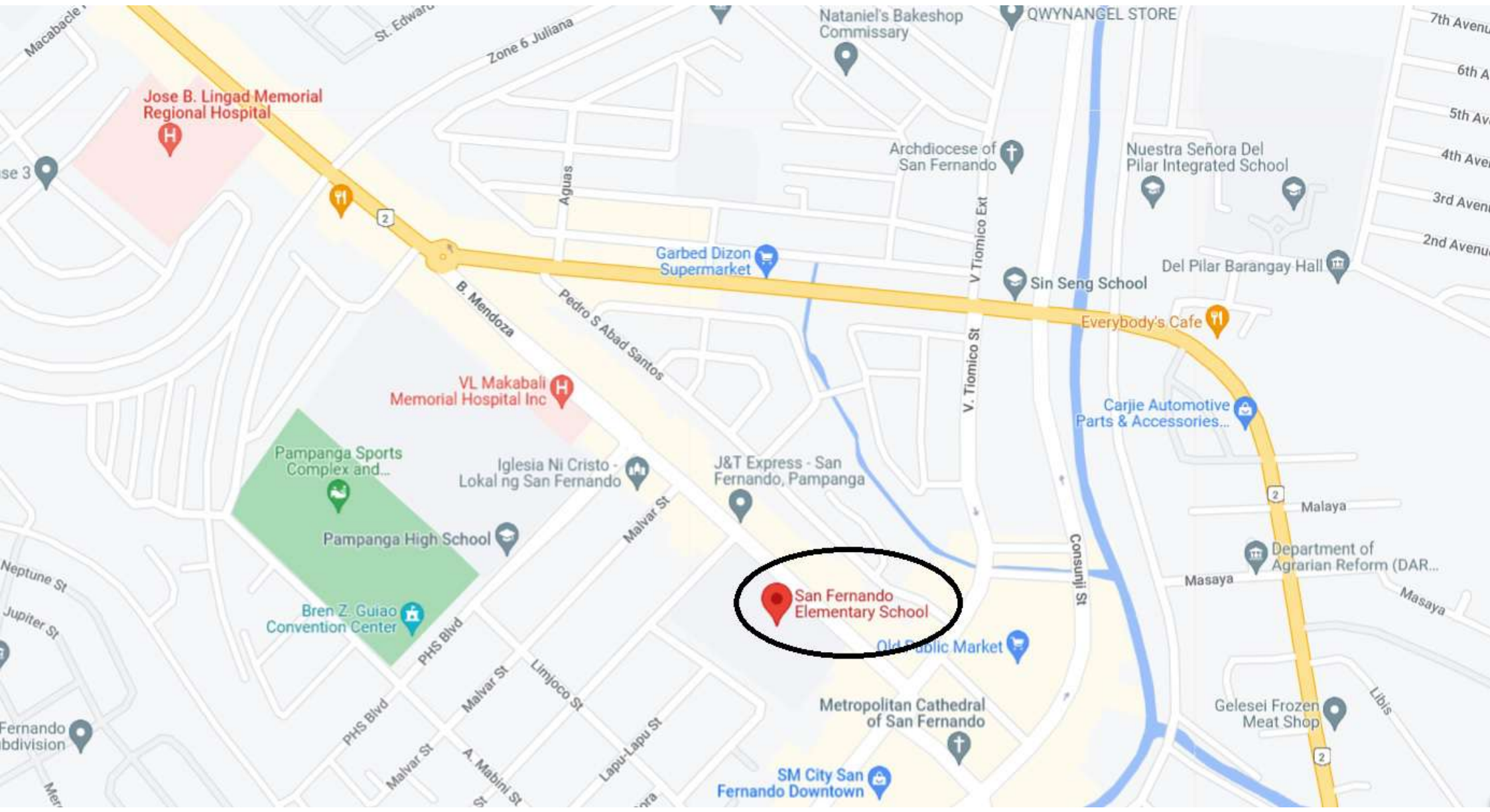

# REMINDER TO EXAMINEES

1. Examinees may report at the examination venue as early as 5:30 AM on the day of the examination. Late examinees will not be admitted;
2. Wear the prescribed attire as per examination program (see link below for the copy of program);
3. Bring your food and drinks for the entire day and necessary medications, including hygiene and sanitary kits in a TRANSPARENT/CLEAR containers/cellophanes. No examinee shall be allowed to leave the examination room during conduct of the examination except for restroom necessities;
4. Bring your Notice of Admission (NOA);
5. Bringing devices into the examination venue that can send messages, communicate, or take photos—such as cellphones, smartwatches, cameras, and similar gadgets—is strictly prohibited.
6. Review materials and other prohibited printed items are not allowed in the testing center premises;
7. Bags of any kind (ladies' bag, shoulder bag, attaché case, backpacks, etc.) are PROHIBITED. Please use a TRANSPARENT PLASTIC ENVELOPE to hold all items you'll be bringing to the exam, such as your NOA, valid ID, and other allowed materials;
8. Do not entertain impostors and fixers asking for money in exchange for favorable exam results;
9. Abide by the instructions provided by the room watchers and floor supervisors;

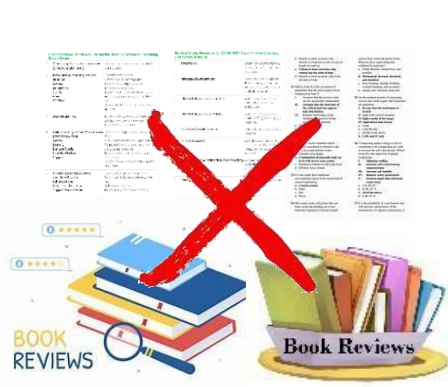
Non-compliance to any of the said protocols shall be dealt with accordingly.

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1. Check or verify your school/building assignments at the PRC official website ([www.prc.gov.ph](http://www.prc.gov.ph)) or through the Notices/ Announcements to be posted at the PRC premises two (2) to three (3) working days before the date of examination.
2. On the day of the examination, report to the school/building assignment not later than 6:30 A.M. Be punctual. **Late examinees will not be admitted.**
3. Examinees are required to wear the following attire on examination day:
  - a. Male examinee - Tucked-in white polo shirt with collar (without any seal, logo, or mark) Decent pants or slacks
  - b. Female examinees - Tucked-in white blouse or shirt with collar (without any seal, logo, or mark) Decent pants or slacks
4. Bring the following on examination day:
  - a. Notice of Admission
  - b. One (1) piece Long Transparent White Plastic Envelope (for keeping your valuables and other allowed items)
  - c. One (1) piece long size brown envelope
  - d. Two (2) or more Pencils (No. 2)
  - e. Ball pen with **black ink only**.
  - f. All packed lunches must be placed in a transparent container.
  - g. Bottled water or drinks must not have labels.
5. The following are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** inside the examination premises:
  - a. Books, notes, review materials, and other materials containing coded data/information/ formula;
  - b. **For LEPT Elementary Level- ALL KINDS OF CALCULATOR  
For LEPT Secondary Level- ALL KINDS OF CALCULATOR EXCEPT FOR THOSE WITH MATHEMATICS MAJOR PURSUANT TO COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 1809-2024.**
  - ONLY ONE CALCULATOR SHALL BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE EXAMINATION ROOM. ALL CALCULATORS SHALL BE INSPECTED AND HAVE TO BE RESET BEFORE THE START OF THE EXAMINATION.**
  - c. **APPLE, SAMSUNG AND OTHER SMART WATCHES, CELLULAR PHONES, EAR PLUGS, TRANSMITTERS, PORTABLE COMPUTERS, BLUETOOTH AND OTHER ELECTRONIC GADGETS/DEVICES WHICH MAY BE USED TO STORE OR RETRIEVE DATA/INFORMATION AND/OR TO COMMUNICATE FOR WHATEVER PURPOSES;**
  - d. Bags of any kind (ladies bags, shoulder bags, attache case, backpacks, etc.)
  - e. Other examination aids not stated in this program.

The rules on the conduct of bodily search, inspection of personal belongings of the examinees, and the seizure/confiscation of prohibited items during the licensure exam (Annex A of PRC Memorandum Order No. 57, s. 2020) shall be strictly observed.

6. Examinees and examination personnel are encouraged to observe the minimum health standards per DOH Circular No. 0324 (s. 2023)<sup>1</sup> throughout the conduct of the examination.
7. Read carefully and follow the instructions on your **NOTICE OF ADMISSION**.

**NOTE: PERSONAL BELONGINGS BROUGHT BY AN EXAMINEE SHALL BE FOR HIS/HER OWN ACCOUNT. THE PRC WILL NOT BE ANSWERABLE FOR ANY SUCH ITEM OR PERSONAL BELONGING THAT MIGHT BE LOST DURING THE EXAM WITHOUT FAULT OR NEGLIGENCE ON ITS PART.**
