The Professional Regulation Commission - Regional Office XII announces the guidelines for the February 2026 Licensure Examination for Professional Teachers in Koronadal City, General Santos City, and Kidapawan City.

Venues for the Examination:

KORONADAL CITY

Required items and documents on the examination day

1. Notice of Admission
2. Official Receipt of payment of the application for examination
3. Two or more No. 2 pencils
4. Ball pens with BLACK ink only
5. One (1) piece long-size brown envelope
6. One (1) long transparent white plastic envelope for keeping valuables and other permitted items.

Prohibited items inside the examination premises

1. Books, notes, review materials, and all other printed items containing coded data, information, or formulas.
2. For LEPT Elementary Level- ALL KINDS OF CALCULATORS
FOR LEPT SECONDARY LEVEL, ALL KINDS OF CALCULATORS EXCEPT THOSE WITH A MATHEMATICS MAJOR, PURSUANT TO COMMISSION RESOLUTION NO. 1809-2024.
ONLY ONE CALCULATOR PER EXAMINEE SHALL BE ALLOWED IN THE EXAMINATION ROOM. ALL CALCULATORS SHALL BE INSPECTED AND RESET BEFORE THE START OF THE EXAMINATION.
3. Apple, Samsung, and other smart watches, cellular phones, earplugs, Bluetooth transmitters, portable computers, and other electronic devices that may be used to store or retrieve data and/or information and/or to communicate for any purpose.
4. Bags of all types (ladies' bags, shoulder bags, attaché cases, backpacks, etc.).
5. Other examination aids not included in the board program

Examinees are strongly advised NOT TO BRING ANY PROHIBITED ITEMS onto the exam premises. Merely possessing any prohibited item will be presumed to indicate an "intent to cheat" or "to violate exam rules and regulations," as outlined in PRC Memorandum Order No. 57, series of 2020.

NOTE: PERSONAL BELONGINGS BROUGHT BY AN EXAMINEE SHALL BE FOR HIS/HER OWN ACCOUNT. THE PRC WILL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY SUCH ITEM OR PERSONAL BELONGING LOST DURING THE EXAM WITHOUT FAULT OR NEGLIGENCE ON ITS PART.

What to Wear on Exam Day

- **Male Examinees** - Tucked-in white polo shirt with a collar (without any seal, logo, or mark), and decent pants or slacks
- **Female Examinees** - Tucked-in white blouse or shirt with a collar (without any seal, logo, or mark), and decent pants or slacks

General Instructions for Examinees

1. Verify your school assignment on the PRC official website (www.prc.gov.ph) two to three working days before the exam. Visit your assigned building before the exam.
2. Report to your building assignment before 6:30 A.M. Be punctual. Late arrivals will not be admitted.
3. The rules for conducting bodily searches, inspecting examinees' personal belongings, and seizing or confiscating prohibited items during the licensure exam, as outlined in Annex A of PRC Memorandum Order No. 57, series of 2020, must be strictly followed.
4. Before entering the examination premises, each examinee must submit to and agree to a search of their person or belongings. If prohibited items are found, they will be held in the Commission's custody for investigation until a final, enforceable decision is rendered.
5. Except for restroom use, no examinee may leave the examination room during the test.
6. Loitering and unnecessary conversations in hallways or exam rooms are strictly prohibited.
7. Upon entering the exam room, examinees must bring their pre-packed meals, snacks, and water to their assigned seats.
8. Minimize the use of PET bottles, plastic wrap, and food packaging to support the city's waste management efforts. Dispose of trash properly in designated bins.
9. Examinees and exam staff are advised to follow the minimum health standards outlined in DOH Circular No. 0324 (s. 2023) during the exam.
10. Read carefully and follow the instructions in your NOTICE OF ADMISSION.
11. Cheating and all other prohibited acts, as outlined in Memorandum Order No. 57, series of 2020, that undermine the integrity and credibility of the licensure examination will be addressed.
