The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **1,175** out of **2,478** passed the Midwife Licensure Examination given by the **Board of Midwifery** in the cities of **Manila, Baguio, Cagayan de Oro, Cebu, Davao, Iloilo, Legazpi, Lucena, Pagadian, Tacloban, Tuguegarao and Zamboanga** this **November 2018**.

From November 14 to November 15, 2018, registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will be done on-line. Please go to [www.prc.gov.ph](http://www.prc.gov.ph) and follow instructions for initial registration. Those who will register are required to bring the following: downloaded duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, notice of admission (for identification only), 2 pieces passport sized pictures (colored with white background and complete name tag), 2 sets of documentary stamps and 1 piece short brown envelope. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**
