 - a. Two (2) or more pencils (No. 1 or 2)
 - b. Ballpens with **BLACK ink only**
 - c. One piece long brown envelope
 - d. One piece long transparent/plastic envelope
 - e. **ORDINARY MAGNIFYING GLASS OR HORSESHOE MICROSCOPE**
4. The following items are **PROHIBITED** inside the examination premises/rooms:
 - a. Books, notes, review materials, and other printed materials containing coded data/information/formula
 - b. **DIGITAL AND MODIFIED MAGNIFYING LENS**
 - c. **ALL KINDS OF CALCULATOR**
 - d. **APPLE, SAMSUNG AND OTHER SMART WATCHES, CELLULAR PHONES, EAR PLUGS, BLUETOOTH, TRANSMITTERS, PORTABLE COMPUTERS, AND OTHER ELECTRONIC GADGETS/DEVICES WHICH MAY BE USED TO STORE OR RETRIEVE DATA/INFORMATION AND/OR TO COMMUNICATE FOR WHATEVER PURPOSE**
 - d. Bags of any kind (place your documents inside the transparent/plastic envelope)
 - e. Other examination aides not stated in this program

The rules on the conduct of bodily search, inspection of personal belongings of the examinees, and the seizure/confiscation of prohibited items during the licensure exam (Annex A of PRC Memorandum Order No. 57, s. 2020) shall be strictly observed.
