**APPROVAL OF APPLICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION WITHOUT EXAMINATION FOR
MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNICIAN**

WHEREAS, Section 21(3)¹ of Republic Act (RA) No.5527, also known as the “Philippine Medical Technology Act of 1969”, as amended, states that the Professional Regulatory Board of Medical Technology (Board) shall issue certificate of registration as medical laboratory technician without examination;

WHEREAS, the Professional Regulation Commission (Commission) issued Memorandum Order No. 01 (s 2020) on the Revised Guidelines on Transmittal and Action of For the Board” application documents from the Regional Offices;
