## PROFESSIONAL REGULATORY BOARD OF MEDICAL TECHNOLOGY RESOLUTION NO. 44 Series of 2023

## APPROVAL OF APPLICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION WITHOUT EXAMINATION AS MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNICIANS

WHEREAS, Section 21(3)<sup>1</sup> of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 5527, also known as the "Philippine Medical Technology Act of 1969", as amended, states that the Professional Regulatory Board of Medical Technology (Board) shall issue a certificate of registration without examination as medical laboratory technician, subject to compliance with the conditions therein prescribed;

WHEREAS, the Professional Regulation Commission (Commission) issued Memorandum Order No. 01 (s. 2020) on the "Revised Guidelines on Transmittal and Action of 'For the Board' (FTB) application documents from the Regional Offices";

WHEREAS, for consideration of the Board are below applicants for registration without examination as Medical Laboratory Technicians in accordance with Section 21(3) of R.A. No. 5527, as amended:

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Has failed to pass the board examination for medical technology but had obtained a general rating of at least 70%. Provided, finally, that a registered medical laboratory technician when employed in the government shall have the equivalent civil service eligibility not lower than second grade.

WHEREFORE, the Board RESOLVES, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to register the above-named applicants as Medical Laboratory Technicians in accordance with Section 21 (3) of R.A. No. 5527, as amended. Upon approval hereof by the Commission and payment of the prescribed fees, let their Certificates of Registration and Professional Identification Cards be issued after they have taken the proper oath.
