**Resolution No. 2019 - 19(A)**

**RECOMMENDING TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE PROFESSIONAL REGULATION COMMISSION, FOR HIS APPROVAL, THE AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF IT EQUIPMENT: PROCUREMENT OF THIRTY (30) UNITS BRAND NEW LASER MONOCHROME MULTIFUNCTION PRINTER TO BUSINESS MACHINES CORPORATION WITH TOTAL BID AMOUNT OF EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE PESOS (Php815,871.00)**

**WHEREAS**, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) caused the posting of the invitation to apply for eligibility and to bid through Public Bidding in the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) website and in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS), and BAC Bulletin Board for the project: Procurement of IT Equipment: Procurement of Thirty (30) Units Brand New Laser Monochrome Multifunction Printer with an approved budget for the contract of Two Million Eight Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Pesos (Php2,889,000.00) only.

**WHEREAS**, on March 25, 2019 BAC issued Bid Bulletin No. 1 reflecting the modification in Section VII Technical Specification of bidding document.

**WHEREAS**, on April 2, 2019 a pre-bid conference was held to explain and clarify the bidding documents and to accommodate any inquiry which the bidders may have. This was attended by ten (10) prospective bidders namely: Business Machines Corporation (Bismac), Link Network Solutions, Inc. (Link Network), Ecopy Corporation (Ecopy), Philcopy Corporation (Philcopy), Pro Event, Quartz Business Products Corporation (Quartz), The Value Systems Phils., Inc. (Value Systems), DCI Int'l IT Solutions (DCI), Unison Computer Systems (Unison), and Otus Copy Systems, Inc. (Otus). Only Quartz, Unison, Bismac, Optimal Systems Distribution, Inc. (Optimal), & Delsan Office Corporation (Delsan) purchased the Bidding Documents.

**WHEREAS**, as a result of the discussion during the pre-bid conference, the BAC issued Bid Bulletin No. 2 dated April 2, 2019 reflecting the modifications/amendments to the Technical Specifications in the bidding documents and rescheduling of the submission and opening of bids on April 23, 2019. The same was posted in PhilGeps and PRC Website.

**WHEREAS**, on April 15, 2019, BAC issued Bid Bulletin No. 3 rescheduling the April 23, 2019 submission and opening of bids to April 30, 2019.

**WHEREAS**, Section 30, Rule IX of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, known as the Government Procurement Reform Act requires that the preliminary examination of the bids be conducted by merely checking for the presence or absence of documentary requirements using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion. If a bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated "passed" for the particular requirement. In this regard, bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered as "failed".



**WHEREAS**, on April 30, 2019, the BAC opened and evaluated the submitted eligibility and technical requirements wherein only Quartz, Bismac, and Optimal passed. In this regard, the BAC proceeded to open their respective financial bid proposal, to wit:

- a) Quartz Php923,100.00
- b) Bismac Php815,871.00
- c) Optimal Php1,500,000.00

**WHEREAS**, during the same opening and evaluation of bids, both Delsan and Unison were given failed marks on their evaluation sheet for the reason that Delsan failed to submit its Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid, while Unison did not acknowledge Section IV General Condition of the Contract (GCC) and Section V Special Condition for the Contract (SCC) as part of Technical Documents. They were given three (3) calendar days to file a Motion for Reconsideration (MR), but they manifested that they will no longer file a motion and requested for the return of their unopened financial bid documents.

**WHEREAS**, Bismac, having passed the eligibility and technical evaluation during evaluation of bid, was declared as the Lowest Calculated Bidder (LCB) and was subjected to post-qualification.

**WHEREAS**, on May 7, 2019, a post-qualification was conducted at Bismac Office located at Carson Bldg. Orense St. Guadalupe Nuevo, Makati City to verify, validate, and ascertain all statements made in its Eligibility and Technical Bid Envelopes during the submission and opening of bids, including the additional requirements submitted by the bidder.

**WHEREAS**, Bismac, having passed the post-qualification, was declared to be the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder.

**WHEREFORE**, the **BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE RESOLVES**, as it hereby **RESOLVED**, to recommend to the Chairman of the Professional Regulation Commission, for his approval, the award of contract for the **PROCUREMENT OF IT EQUIPMENT: PROCUREMENT OF THIRTY (30) UNITS BRAND NEW LASER MONOCHROME MULTIFUNCTION PRINTER to BUSINESS MACHINES CORPORATION** with bid amount of **EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY-ONE PESOS (Php815,871.00)**.
