Pharmacist

A pharmacist is a licensed healthcare professional whose role has evolved from providing "compounding and dispensing services" to "medication therapy management", performing various roles to ensure that patients achieve optimal health outcomes through the proper use of pharmaceutical products.

Basic Educational Requirement

- 4-year Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy degree; 960 hours of internship under the supervision of a licensed pharmacist.
- Must pass the Pharmacist Licensure Examination given by the Professional Regulatory Board of Pharmacy of the Professional Regulation Commission.



Cost of Education

Cost of Pharmacy education may range from Php 20,000 to Php 65,000 per semester in private institutions. The cost may be 40 - 75% lower in government educational institutions.
