**ELECTRICAL ENGINEER LICENSURE EXAMINATION
RESULTS RELEASED IN THREE (3) WORKING DAYS**

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **3,135** out of **4,697 Registered Electrical Engineers** and **2,649** out of **4,251 Registered Master Electricians** successfully passed the Electrical Engineer Licensure Examinations given by the **Board of Electrical Engineering** in **Manila, Baguio, Cagayan De Oro, Cebu, Davao, Iloilo, Legazpi, Lucena, Tacloban and Zamboanga** this **September 2018**.

The members of the Board of Electrical Engineering who gave the licensure examinations are **Engr. Francis V. Mapile**, Chairman and **Engr. Jaime V. Mendoza**, Member.

The results were released in three (3) working days after the last day of examinations.

From September 17 to September 24, 2018, registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will be done on-line. Please go to www.prc.gov.ph and follow instructions for initial registration. Those who will register are required to bring the following: downloaded duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, notice of admission (for identification only), 2 pieces passport sized pictures (colored with white background and complete name tag), 2 sets of documentary stamps and 1 piece short brown envelope. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The date and venue for the oath-taking ceremony of the new successful examinees in the said examinations **WILL BE ANNOUNCED LATER.**
