CANCELLATION OF THE SEPTEMBER 2025 LICENSURE EXAMINATION FOR PROFESSIONAL TEACHERS IN REGIONS I, II AND THE CORDILLERA ADMINISTRATIVE REGION, AND RESCHEDULING THEREOF TO NOVEMBER 30, 2025

WHEREAS, Section 7(d) of Republic Act No. 8981, otherwise known as the "*PRC Modernization Act of 2000*", empowers the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC/Commission) to administer and conduct licensure examinations of the various Professional Regulatory Boards, promulgate the necessary rules and regulations in connection therewith, and determine and fix the places and dates of said examinations;

WHEREAS, the Commission issued Resolution No. 1927 (s. 2024), scheduling the Licensure Examination for Professional Teachers (LEPT) on September 21, 2025 in various testing centers nationwide and in Thailand and Hong Kong;

WHEREAS, the Commission issued Resolution No. 1178 (s. 2019), on the "*Revised Guidelines on the Suspension or Cancellation of Licensure Examination during Inclement Weather and Other Unexpected Disasters*", in order to ensure the safety of examinees and examination personnel during inclement weather and other unexpected disasters;

WHEREAS, in the days leading up to the scheduled examination date, continuous monitoring and close coordination were maintained with the Office of Civil Defense (OCD) and the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA);

WHEREAS, on the evening of September 20, 2025, an emergency meeting was convened by the OCD and PAGASA, where the PRC was informed of the intensification of Typhoon "Nando", which was projected to bring severe and potentially destructive weather conditions to Regions I, II, and the Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR);

WHEREAS, it was confirmed during said meeting that Typhoon "Nando" could reach *Super Typhoon* category, with the potential to trigger Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal No. 5 and dangerously enhance the Southwest Monsoon, posing significant threats to the safety of the public, especially those traveling to and from examination centers;

WHEREAS, the weather system was further complicated by Tropical Storm "Mitag" (formerly TS Mirasol) located in Batanes, which brought continuous thunderstorms and heavy rainfall to elevated and offshore areas in Northern Luzon;

WHEREAS, while the Commission had intended to proceed with the scheduled examinations, the rapidly evolving and worsening weather conditions posed substantial risks, warranting immediate action in the interest of public safety;

WHEREAS, the health, safety and well-being of examinees, PRC examination personnel, and volunteer proctors remain the Commission's utmost priority and a main consideration in decisions involving the conduct of licensure examinations;

WHEREAS, on September 22, 2025, the Professional Regulatory Board for Professional Teachers and the Licensure Office conducted a joint coordination meeting with relevant PRC offices, and unanimously recommended the cancellation of the September 2025 LEPT in the affected regions and its rescheduling to November 30, 2025.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, the Commission **RESOLVES**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to **CANCEL** the conduct of the **September 2025 Licensure Examination for Professional Teachers in Regions I, II and CAR**.
