TERMS OF REFERENCE (TOR)

Procurement of Printing Services for the International Conferences under the International Commitments Funds (ICF) 2020

Rationale

The Professional Regulation Commission will be hosting the First Southeast Asian Librarians Leadership Convergence (A Prelude to the Establishment of Mutual Recognition of Professional Qualifications) on 10-11 November 2020.

These activities are intended to promote and mainstream the current thrusts of the Commission in adopting a more lenient and facilitated process of arriving to an arrangement for the recognition of professional qualifications, and to facilitate wider mobility of Filipino professionals in foreign countries, through the Mutual Recognition of Professional Qualifications (MRPQ).

To maximize attainment of the objectives of the event, an external service provider shall be contracted with the following terms and conditions:

Approved Budget for the Contract

The service provider shall bid for all items described in this Terms of Reference, which shall not exceed the Approved Budget for the Contract in the total amount of **Php 10,000.00** inclusive of all applicable bank and government charges.

II. Scope of Service

The service provider shall be able to provide the Customization of Crystal Plaques for the event to be given as token of appreciation for local resource speakers.

Qualification Requirements

- The service provider must previously have the same transaction with any government agency.
- The service provider shall deliver the item 1 week before the event.
