Resolution No. 2022 - 85

**DECLARATION OF FAILURE OF BIDDING FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF TWO
BAY HARD DISK DRIVE DOCKING STATIONS WITH A TOTAL APPROVED
BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT OF ONE HUNDRED THIRTEEN THOUSAND
SEVEN HUNDRED PESOS (PHP113,700.00) THROUGH NEGOTIATED
PROCUREMENT UNDER SECTION 53.9 – SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT**

WHEREAS, the invitation to apply for eligibility and to bid through Negotiated Procurement under Section 53.9 – Small Value Procurement was posted in the website of the Commission, at the Bids Awards Committee (BAC) Bulletin Board, and in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) for the project: Procurement of Two Bay Hard Disk Drive Docking Stations with an approved budget for the contract of One Hundred Thirteen Thousand Seven Hundred Pesos (Php113,700.00) only.

WHEREAS, several prospective bidders were also invited through electronic mail to submit quotation for the project;

WHEREAS, during the scheduled deadline and submission of bid proposals on September 1, 2022, two (2) bidders participated and submitted its eligibility and technical requirements, namely: The Value Systems Integration Inc. (Value Systems), Metos Offshore, Inc. (Metos).

WHEREAS, during the opening and evaluation of bid, Value Systems failed to submit a notarized Secretary's Certificate, while Metos failed to submit a signed and acknowledged Terms of Reference (Annex A") and Official Bid form (Annex "B"). Therefore, both bidders were marked as failed and declared as disqualified.

WHEREAS, Section 30, Rule IX of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184, known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, requires that the preliminary examination of the bids be conducted by merely checking for the presence or absence of documentary requirements using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion. If a bidder submits the required document, it shall be rated "passed" for the particular requirement. In this regard, bids that fail to include any requirement or are incomplete or patently insufficient shall be considered as "failed".

WHEREAS, Section 35, Rule X of the 2016 Revised IRR provides for the authority of the BAC to declare a failure of bidding in cases where no bidders responded to the request for quotation, to wit:

Section 35. Failure of Bidding

35.1 The BAC shall declare the bidding a failure when:

- a) No bids are received;
- b) All prospective bidders are declared ineligible;**

- c) All bids fail to comply with all the bid requirements or post-qualification, or x xxx (Emphasis supplied)

WHEREAS, Section 35. 2 of the same IRR provides for the steps and procedures that the BAC should take in case of failure of bidding; x x x to wit:

35.2. In order to determine the reason for the failed bidding, the BAC shall conduct a mandatory review and evaluation of the terms, conditions, and specifications in the Bidding Documents, including its cost estimates.

35.3. Based on its findings, the BAC shall revise the terms, conditions, and specifications, and if necessary, adjust the ABC, subject to the required approvals, and conduct a re-bidding with re-advertisement and/or posting, as provided for in Section 21.2 of this IRR.(a) (underscoring supplied)

WHEREFORE, the **BIDS AND AWARDS COMMITTEE RESOLVES**, as it hereby **RESOLVED**, to **DECLARE A FAILURE OF BIDDING FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF TWO BAY HARD DISK DRIVE DOCKING STATIONS** with a total approved budget for the contract of **ONE HUNDRED THIRTEEN THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED PESOS (PHP113,700.00)**. Consequently, the BAC shall conduct a re-bidding with re-advertisement and/or posting of said procurement project.
