## INVITATION TO BID FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF LAPTOPS FOR PRC OFFICERS, OFFICIALS, AND ICTS PERSONNEL (2 LOTS)-REBID

1. The PROFESSIONAL REGULATION COMMISSION – CENTRAL OFFICE (PRC-CO) through the Government of the Philippines (GOP), the General Appropriations Act (GAA) of 2025 (R.A. No. 12116 dated December 30, 2024) intends to apply the sum Three Million Five Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand Forty-Nine Pesos and Sixty-Two Centavos (Php3,552,049.62) being the Total Approved Budget for the Contracts (ABC) to payments under the contract for the following:

Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

- 2. The PRC CO now invites bids for the above procurement project. Delivery of the Goods is required within the duration indicated in the Schedule of Requirements from the receipt of Notice to Proceed. Bidders should have completed, within four (4) years specifically from January 2021 to the date of submission and opening of bids, a contract equivalent to at least 50% of the ABC that is similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
- Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from PRC CO Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) Secretariat and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours.

**THOUSAND PESOS (Php5,000.00).** The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees in person at the address given below.

- 6. The PRC-CO will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on June 04, 2025 at 01:30 PM via videoconferencing, which is open to prospective bidders. For proper coordination, all interested bidders are hereby requested to submit their Letter of Intent to participate, including their contact details and send it to bac@prc.gov.ph on or before June 03, 2025.
- 7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat at the office address indicated below on or before JUNE 17, 2025 at 10:00 AM. Late bids shall not be accepted.
- 8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in Section II, Instructions to Bidders, Item No. 14.
- 9. Bid opening shall be on JUNE 17, 2025 at 01:30 PM at the given address below. Bidders may attend the bid opening via videoconferencing or in person.
- 10. The PRC-CO reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
