

NON-PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS (Please refer to Commission Resolution No. 1809-2024 or the "Updated list of Non-Programmable Calculators Allowed to be used in the Licensures Examinations") NOTE: ONLY ONE CALCULATOR SHALL BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE EXAMINATION ROOM. CALCULATORS SHALL BE INSPECTED AND HAVE TO BE RESET BEFORE THE START OF THE EXAMINATION.
- 8. Bring food and water. It must be packed in transparent containers.

- 5. The following are **STRICTLY PROHIBITED** inside the examination premises/rooms:
 - a. Books, notes, review materials, and other materials containing coded data/ information/ formula.
 - b. PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS or calculators with embedded functions especially CASIO FX991ES and CASIO FX-991ES plus
 - c. APPLE, SAMSUNG AND OTHER SMART WATCHES, CELLULAR PHONES, EAR PLUGS, TRANSMITTERS, PORTABLE COMPUTERS, BLUETOOTH AND OTHER ELECTRONIC GADGETS/DEVICES WHICH MAY BE USED TO RETRIEVE DATA/INFORMATION AND/OR TO COMMUNICATE FOR WHATEVER PURPOSES
 - d. Bags of any kind (ladies bags, shoulder bags, attaché case, backpacks, etc.)
 - e. Other examination aids not stated in this program.

The rules on the conduct of bodily search, inspection of personal belongings of the examinees, and the seizure/confiscation of prohibited items during the licensure exam (Annex A of PRC Memorandum Order No. 57, s. 2020) shall be strictly observed.

- 6. Examinees and examination personnel are encouraged to observe the minimum health standards per DOH Circular No. 0324 (s. 2023)¹ throughout the conduct of the examination
- 7. Read carefully and follow the instructions on your **NOTICE OF ADMISSION** and **EXAMINEES GUIDE**.

Resolution No. <u>1809</u> Series of 2024

UPDATED LIST OF NON-PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS ALLOWED TO BE USED IN THE LICENSURE EXAMINATIONS

WHEREAS, Republic Act (R.A.) No. 8981, or the "PRC Modernization Act of 2000", empowers the Professional Regulation Commission (Commission) to administer, implement and enforce the regulatory policies of the national government with respect to the regulation and licensing of the professions under its jurisdiction; administer and conduct the licensure examinations of the various regulatory Boards in accordance with the rules and regulations promulgated; and adopt measures to preserve the integrity and inviolability of the licensure examinations, among others;

WHEREAS, the Commission, pursuant to its powers under the same Act, issued Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 21 (s. 2009), prescribing the list of non-programmable calculators to be used by the examinees in all licensure examinations;

WHEREAS, some of the models in the list of allowed non-programmable calculators under MC No. 21 (s. 2009) are found to be outdated since most of them are phased-out and are commercially unavailable;

WHEREAS, the Commission recognizes the importance of ensuring that the list of non-programmable calculators allowed in the licensure examinations are up-to-date and easily accessible:

WHEREAS, it is also important to have an updated list of allowed non-programmable calculators for the guidance of the Commission Regional Offices, the examinees, and other stakeholders;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission RESOLVES, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to recommend the Updated List of Non-Programmable Calculators Allowed to be Used in Licensure Examinations as shown in "Annex A".

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the following additional guidelines be properly followed:

- a. Only one (1) non-programmable calculator per examinee shall be allowed inside the examination room. All calculators shall be thoroughly inspected by the examination personnel every examination day.
- b. Borrowing, lending and substitution/replacement of calculators while the examination is in progress shall not be allowed.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that:

- a. Professional Regulatory Boards (PRBs) that have their own list of allowable calculators may continue to use their existing Resolution, which shall be clearly stated in their licensure examination program;
- b. PRBs that prefer to have their own list of allowable calculators may issue their own *Resolution*;
- PRBs may completely disallow calculators in their licensure examinations which shall be clearly stated in their licensure examination program; and

d. Calculators listed in MC No. 21 (s. 2009) that are still available in the market may be used in licensure examinations, with the exception of that mentioned in MC No. 01 (s. 2018) on "Disallowing the Use of Casio Calculator FX-991ES and FX 991ES Plus in the Licensure Examinations, and other Special Rules on the Use of Calculators during the Licensure Examinations" and Casio Calculator FX-570ES Plus which has been repeatedly discovered to have been used for cheating by, but not limited to, being modified to transmit and receive data.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately following its publication in the Official Gazette or a newspaper of general circulation and the submission of a copy thereof to the Office of the National Administrative Register of the University of the Philippines.
