

Percentage of cases resolved within three (3) months		8%	8%	8%	8%	8%	7.3%	5.7%	4.16%	3.47%	5.16%	-2.84%	The decrease in the number of case disposal during the period can be attributed to several logistical challenges such as but not limited to the implementation of the modified enhanced community quarantine (MECQ) and/or enhanced community quarantine (ECQ), the suspension of hearings, lack of access to case folders, belated receipt of pleadings filed by the parties, and unavailability of registered return cards that confirm receipt of PRC issuances. Further, the decrease can also be attributed to evident lack of manpower as lawyers and staff perform multiple functions that heavily affect their core functions as the number of cases filed continue to increase on a monthly basis.

With the issuance of PRC Resolution No. 1471, s.2021 dated 29 December 2021, on the revised guidelines on the conduct of inspection and monitoring of Higher Education Institutions and establishments, scheduled inspections and monitoring will be conducted in 2022.


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
