Examinees are reminded to bring the following to the examination venues, to wit:

- a. Printed Notice of Admission (NOA)
- b. Printed Copy of SC-CCTS QR Code
- c. Informed Consent Form: Annex A
- d. Health Declaration Form: Annex B
- e. Negative RT-PCR Test Results (Nasopharyngeal and Oropharyngeal) or Saliva Test of Philippine Red Cross taken within the period of 2 to 5 days prior the examination
- f. Government- issued Identification Card

In addition, examinees are reminded to observe the protocols and guidelines set in the Addendum to Executive Order No. 39-A, Series of 2021 issued by the Local Government Unit of Koronadal City dated September 14, 2021, to wit:

- 1. **No Covid- Symptoms** Only examinees who do not exhibit Covid-19 symptoms are allowed to enter the examination venues;
- 2. Strict observance of minimum public health standards shall be complied with all times, such as:
 - a. Mandatory wearing of face mask and other protective gear/equipment;
 - b. Frequent handwashing with soap and water and/or use of alcohol;
 - Strictly observe the required 1-2 meter social/physical distancing at all times;
 and
 - d. Cough etiquette.
- 3. Transportation only the driver and the examinees shall be allowed to board and upon inspection shall present the Notice of Admission (NoA) and Government-issued Identification Card.
- > Examinees are required to bring their food for lunch and snacks and No Food deliveries during the entire duration of the licensure examinations.
- Examinees are prohibited to use cellular phone for the entire examination period, even during break time.
