**ARCHITECT LICENSURE EXAMINATION
RESULTS RELEASED IN SEVEN (7) WORKING DAYS (50% Passed)**

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **550** out of **1,092** passed the Architect Licensure Examination (ALE) given by the **Board of Architecture** headed by its Chairman, **Arch. Armando N. Alli** with two other members, **Arch. Angeline T. Chua Chiacó** and **Arch. Marietta Bundalian Segovia**. The examination was held in **Manila** this **January 15 & 17, 2010**.

The results were released in seven (7) working days after the last day of examination.

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will start on February 3, 2010, Wednesday but not later than March 5, 2010, Friday. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 2 pieces passport size picture (colored with white background and complete name tag), 1 piece 1" x 1" picture (colored with white background and complete name tag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps, and 1 short brown envelope with name and profession; and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of P600 and Annual Registration Fee of P450 for 2010-2013. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The oath taking ceremony of the successful examinees in the said examination as well as the previous ones who have not taken their Oath of Professional will be held before the Board on March 14, 2010, Sunday, at 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon at the Fiesta Pavilion, Manila Hotel, One Rizal Park, Manila.

Pursuant to Section 40 of Republic Act 9266, mandatory registration for membership with the **United Architects of the Philippines, Inc. (UAP-IAPOA)**, will start on Wednesday, February 3, 2010.
