The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **239** out of **405** passed the Chemical Engineer Licensure Examination given by the **Board of Chemical Engineering in Manila** this **May 2015**

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will be on May 25 & 26, 2015. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 1 piece passport size picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps and 1 short brown envelope with name and profession and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of ₱600 and Annual Registration Fee of ₱450 for 2015-2018. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The date and venue for the oath-taking ceremony of the new successful examinees in the said examination **WILL BE ANNOUNCED LATER.**
