The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **466** out of **874** passed the Chemical Engineer Licensure Examination given by the **Board of Chemical Engineering** in **Manila** and **Cebu** this **November 2015**

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will be on November 26 and 27, 2015. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyon, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 1 piece passport size picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps and 1 short brown envelope with name and profession and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of ₱600 and Annual Registration Fee of ₱450 for 2015-2018. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The date and venue for the oath-taking ceremony of the new successful examinees in the said examination **WILL BE ANNOUNCED LATER.**
