**MINING ENGINEER LICENSURE EXAMINATION
RESULTS RELEASED IN ONE (1) WORKING DAY**

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **11** out of **18** passed the Mining Engineer Licensure Examination given by the **Board of Mining Engineering** in **Manila** this **August 2009**.

The members of the Board of Mining Engineering are **Cornelio Q. Casido**, Chairman; **Rufino B. Bomasang** and **Augusto C. Villaluna**, Members.

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will start on Thursday, August 27, 2009 but not later than September 8, 2009. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 2 pieces passport size picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 1 piece 1" x 1" picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps, and 1 short brown envelope with name and profession; and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of ₱600 and Annual Registration Fee of ₱450 for 2009-2012. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The oathtaking ceremony of the successful examinees in the said examination as well as the previous ones who have not taken their Oath of Professional will be held before the Board on Friday, September 11, 2009 at 9:00 o'clock in the morning up to 2:00 o'clock in the afternoon at the Legend Villas, Pioneer Street, Mandaluyong City.

Registration for membership with the **Philippine Society of Mining Engineers (PSEM)** will take place after registration as a professional with the Board and the Commission.
