**MINING ENGINEER LICENSURE EXAMINATION
 RESULTS RELEASED IN ONE (1) DAY**

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **117** out of **141** passed the Mining Engineer Licensure Examination given by the **Board of Mining Engineering** in **Manila** this **August 2013**.

The members of the Board of Mining Engineering are **Cornelio Q. Casido**, Chairman; **Rufino B. Bomasang** and **Augusto C. Villaluna**, Members.

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will be on September 3, 2013. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 1 piece passport size picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps and 1 short brown envelope with name and profession and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of P600 and Annual Registration Fee of P450 for 2013-2016. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The oathtaking ceremony of the successful examinees in the said examination as well as the previous ones who have not taken their Oath of Professional **will be announced later.**
