**PHARMACIST LICENSURE EXAMINATION
RESULTS RELEASED IN TWO DAYS**

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **584** out of **1,042** passed the Pharmacist Licensure Examination given by the **Board of Pharmacy** in the cities of **Manila, Baguio** and **Cebu** this January 2009.

The members of the Board of Pharmacy who gave the licensure examination are **Ms. Catalina C. Sanchez**, Chairman; **Mr. Reynaldo Maxlito H. Umali** and **Ms. Jennifer M. Flores**, Members.

The results were released in two (2) days after the last day of examination.

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will start on Thursday, February 5, 2009 but not later than February 18, 2009. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 2 pieces passport size picture (colored with white background and complete name tag), 1 piece 1" x 1" picture (colored with white background and complete name tag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps, and 1 short plastic envelope with name and profession; and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of ₱600 and Annual Registration Fee of ₱450 for 2009-2012. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The oath-taking ceremony of the successful examinees in the said examination as well as the previous ones who have not taken their Oath of Professional will be held before the Board on Wednesday, February 25, 2009 at 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon at the Fiesta Pavilion, Manila Hotel, One Rizal Park, Roxas Boulevard, Manila.

Registration for membership with the **Philippine Pharmaceutical Association (PPhA), Inc.** will start on Thursday, February 5, 2009.
