 - d. One (1) piece metered-stamped Window Mailing Envelope
 - e. Two or more pencils (No. 2)
 f. Ballpen with **PLACK**
 - Ballpen with BLACK INK ONLY
 - g. One (1) piece Long Brown Envelope
 - h. One (1) piece Long Transparent (non-colored) Plastic Envelope (for keeping your valuables and other allowed items)
 - i. NON-PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS (REFER TO THE LIST IN THE **EXAMINEES' GUIDE)**
- 5. The following are **PROHIBITED** inside the examination premises/rooms:
 - a. Books, notes, review materials, and other printed materials containing coded data/information/formula.
 - b. PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS
 - c. SMART WATCHES, CELLULAR PHONES. EAR PLUGS. TRANSMITTERS, PORTABLE COMPUTERS and other electronic gadgets/devices which may be used for communication purposes.
 - d. Bags of any kind (place your documents inside the transparent/plastic envelope)
 - e. Other examination aides not stated in this program.

- PRC WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PROHIBITED ITEMS THAT NOTE: WILL BE LOST.
