REAL ESTATE BROKER LICENSURE EXAMINATION RESULTS RELEASED IN TWO (2) WORKING DAYS

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **21** out of **55** passed the Real Estate Broker Licensure Examination given by the **Board of Real Estate Service** in **Manila** and **Cagayan de Oro** this **May 2017.**

The members of the Board of Real Estate Service who gave the licensure examination are **Dr. Eduardo G. Ong,** Chairman; **Florencio C. Diño II** and **Rafael M. Fajardo,** Members.

The results were released in two (2) working days after the said examination.

Starting June 13, 2017, registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will be done on-line. Please go to www.prc.gov.ph and follow instructions for initial registration. Those who will register are required to bring the following: Notice of admission, duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, 2 pieces passport size pictures (colored with white background and complete name tag) and 2 sets of documentary stamps and submission of Original Surety Bond, minimum amount of which is P 20,000.00, with the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC)/Housing and Land Use Regulatory Board (HLURB) as Obligee. Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.

The date and venue for the oathtaking ceremony of the new successful examinees in the said examination **WILL BE ANNOUNCED LATER**.
