NOTES FOR REE AND RME:

1. The passing general weighted average rating is seventy percent (70%) with no grade below fifty percent (50%) in any subject.
2. An applicant shall be allowed to retake, any number of times, only the subject/s in which he/she has obtained a grade below fifty percent (50%). When he/she shall have obtained an average grade of seventy percent (70%) in the subject/s repeated, he/she shall be considered to have passed the licensure examination. However, if he/she obtains a grade of less than 70%, he/she will be **CONDITIONED** again and will have to retake the examination on the same subject until he/she shall have obtained a grade of 70% or higher.
3. An examinee who obtains a general average grade of less than seventy percent (70%) is considered **FAILED**. He/she will have to retake all the subjects even though he/she obtained a passing grade in any of the subjects.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Check or verify your school/building assignments at the PRC official website (www.prc.gov.ph) or thru the Notices/Announcements to be posted at the PRC premises two (2) to three (3) working days before the date of examination.

2. Report to the school/building assignment before 6:30 a.m. on the first day of the examination to verify your room and seat number. Be punctual. Late examinees will not be admitted. Examination fee of absent examinees will be forfeited.
3. Examinees are required to wear the following attire every examination day:
 1. Male Examinees - Plain white polo shirt with collar (without any seal, logo or mark)
Decent pants or slacks
 2. Female Examinees - Plain white blouse or shirt with collar (without any seal, logo or mark)
Decent skirt or slacks
4. Bring the following on examination day:
 - a. Notice of Admission
 - b. Official Receipt
 - c. One (1) piece metered-stamped window mailing envelope
 - d. Two (2) or more pencils (No. 2)
 - e. Ballpens with **BLACK ink only**
 - f. one (1) piece long brown envelope
 - g. one (1) piece long transparent/plastic envelope (for keeping your valuables and other allowed items)
5. The following are **PROHIBITED** inside the examination premises/rooms.
 - a. Books, notes, review materials, and other printed materials containing coded data/information/formula.
 - b. **PROGRAMMABLE CALCULATORS.**
 - c. **CELLULAR PHONES**, portable computers or similar gadgets/devices.
 - d. Bags of any kind (ladies bag, shoulder bags, attaché case, backpacks, etc.)
 - e. Other examination aides not stated on this program.
