**LICENSURE EXAMINATION FOR SOCIAL WORKERS
RESULTS RELEASED IN TWO (2) DAYS**

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) announces that **691** out of **1,280** passed the Social Worker Licensure Examination given by the **Board for Social Workers** in the cities of **Manila, Baguio, Cagayan de Oro, Cebu, Davao, Iloilo, Legazpi, Tuguegarao, and Zamboanga** this **June 2009**.

The members of the **Board for Social Workers** are **Monina Cruz-Manapat**, Chairman; **Lorna Camacho-Gabad, Zenaida Felizardo-Leonardo, Leonila Renales-Melendrez**, and **Jesus S. Far**, Members.

The results were released in two (2) days after the last day of examinations.

Registration for the issuance of Professional Identification Card (ID) and Certificate of Registration will start on Monday, July 20, 2009 but not later than August 5, 2009. Those who will register are required to bring the following: duly accomplished Oath Form or Panunumpa ng Propesyonal, current Community Tax Certificate (cedula), 2 pieces passport sized pictures (colored with white background and complete nametag), 1 piece 1" x 1" picture (colored with white background and complete nametag), 2 sets of metered documentary stamps, and 1 short brown envelope with name and profession; and to pay the Initial Registration Fee of ₱600 and Annual Registration Fee of ₱450 for 2009-2012. **Successful examinees should personally register and sign in the Roster of Registered Professionals.**

The oath taking ceremony of the successful examinees in the said examination, as well as the previous ones who have not taken the Professional Oath, will be held before the Board on Friday, August 14, 2009 at 1:00 o'clock in the afternoon at the Centennial Hall, Manila Hotel, One Rizal Park, Manila. All must come in formal attire.

Registration for membership with the **Philippine Association of Social Workers, Inc. (PASWI)** will also start on Monday, July 20, 2009 at PRC.
